Dr Adam Wójcicki got his M.Sc. and Ph.D. from AGH University of Science and Technology, Cracow, PL. In the years 1996-2008 he worked for PBG as a geophysicist, team and project manager (main activity: integrated geophysical-geological interpretation to structural and petroleum geology). He is was a Deputy Editor of Company's bulletin GEOPHYSICS. A.Wójcicki elaborated several FP proposals on energy and environment topics and since 2004 took part in a number of projects on CCS supported by the 6th Framework Programme. He was responsible for already completed Polish part of FP6 (sub)project CASTOR WP1.2 on mapping of CO₂ sources and sinks and participates in ongoing research FP6 project EU GeoCapacity (together with MEERI PAS; on update of emission sources database and evaluating storage potential of coal beds and hydrocarbon fields in Poland). He elaborated on the base of CASTOR WP1.2 results an interactive map of CCS options in Poland which is to be enhanced soon, thanks to funding of Polish Ministry of Environment and EU GeoCapacity input, into the CCS WebGIS for Poland. He is also involved in CO₂NET EAST coordinated action project on extending CO₂ networking activities to ,new' EU member and candidate states, where he is responsible for activities in Poland. Since 2008 he is working in the Polish Geological Institute asa project manager in the field of CO₂ geological storage.

He is ENeRG member and country representative to Poland since 2004.
